

Children's room cleaning plan

DECLUTTERING & ORGANIZING

- collect all toys scattered around the house
- remove all toys that don't belong to the child from his/her room
- sort out all toys- get rid of those that your child is too old to play with, don't like, or with missing pieces
- organize toys by category: animals, doll clothes, puzzles, cars, etc.
- sort out all books that are torn, not age appropriate, etc.
- sort out all clothes; get rid of all that are torn, too small, damaged, etc.
- organize clothes by category: underwear, t-shirts, pullover, pants, etc. (don't forget to pair up the socks and get rid of the ones without a pair)

TIPS: To improve the visual look of the closet use the same hangers and put clothes like underwear, t-shirts, swimming suits into a boxes- fold them and storage horizontally. Organize toys by category and storage them in labeled boxes/baskets.

CLEANING

- change the bedding
- wash/ ventilate the quilt and pillow
- wipe down the wardrobe from outside, top, and inside
- wipe down all the cupboards and shelves
- clean thoroughly any tables and chairs
- wash the curtains
- clean the windows
- remove any stickers from the windows, floor, and furniture
- clean the walls with a magic sponge
- clean/wipe all big toys and their containers
- clean the doors (both sides) plus handles
- hoover and clean the floors
- clean floor under the bed
- wash all stuffed animals
- ventilate the room for 10-15 minutes
